## Nailsea Bowls Club Rules (2021)

## (Amendment to Rules 15c & 15d – Feb 2023)

## **15. BYE-LAWS**

a. The Club shall play under the laws of Bowls England.

b. The playing season shall be fixed by the NBC Management Committee.

c. Players shall wear the club polo shirt for all matches when representing the club, with grey or white trousers as specified by the Captain of the day (see rule 15i below). For internal club matches and roll ups white shirts or club polo shirts are to be worn with grey trousers.

c. Players shall wear the club polo shirt for all matches when representing the club, with grey or white trousers as specified by the Captain of the day (see rule <del>15i</del> [15h] below). [For internal club matches and competitions, white shirts or club polo shirts are to be worn with grey trousers. For Club nights and roll ups it is preferred that white shirts or club polo shirts are to be worn with grey trousers. New members attending coaching and/or club nights should wear comfortable clothing for their first season although white shirts are preferred.]

d. Either the club blazer (which shall be black or blue) or white zip up jacket in white or Club colours, shall be worn to all club matches.

(RULE TO BE DROPPED - NO AMENDMENT)

d. When, in the opinion of any member of the Green Committee, the Green is unfit for play, a notice to that effect shall be posted in the clubroom and on the Green.

e. No person shall be allowed on the Green unless wearing regulation footwear and must not play without using a mat and a ground sheet if so decided by a member of the Green Committee.f. Casual visitors may be introduced by members on payment of a fee which shall be determined

annually by the Committee. The names of all visitors, and of the members introducing them, shall be recorded in a book provided for that purpose.

g. The Green is available for use by members of the public, subject to Bye-laws f[e] and g[f].

h. Team sheets will include the dress code for the match which must be observed.

i. Club competitions must be completed by specified dates, otherwise the defaulter will forfeit the match. Within 2 weeks of the start date of each round the Challenger(s), the first named, must offer their opponent(s) 3 dates/times on which to play the match. At least one of these offers must be for a weekend; no extensions will be granted.
